

How far should the equipment be from the distribution box

A distribution box should generally be installed close enough to the equipment to minimize cable length but maintain at least 1 meter of clearance for safety, maintenance, and ventilation, with specific industrial limits often not exceeding 3 meters horizontally from controlled equipment.

Clearance and Safety Requirements For indoor industrial installations, OSHA requires that switchboards, panelboards, and distribution boards be located in dedicated spaces protected from damage, with the dedicated space extending from the floor to 1.83 meters (6 feet) above the equipment or to the ceiling, whichever is lower. This space must be free of obstacles, piping, or other equipment that could interfere with access or create hazards (). In addition, live parts operating at 50 volts or more must be guarded against accidental contact using approved cabinets or enclosures ().

Practical Installation Distances Industrial settings: Sub-distribution boxes should be installed near the electrical equipment or load they serve, with a horizontal distance not exceeding 3 meters from the controlled equipment (). Total distribution boxes should be located near the main power supply, and sub-distribution boxes should be within 30 meters of the main distribution box ().

Maintenance and access: At least 1 meter of clearance should be maintained around the box to allow inspection, maintenance, and component replacement ().

This ensures safe operation and prevents overheating.

Height considerations: The recommended installation height is typically 1.2 to 1.5 meters from the floor for easy access and operation ().

Additional Considerations Protection from physical damage: If the distribution box is in areas with vehicular traffic, stacked materials, or pedestrian movement, consider physical barriers or enclosures to prevent accidental impact ().

Ventilation and heat dissipation: Ensure adequate ventilation and heat dissipation for the equipment ().
