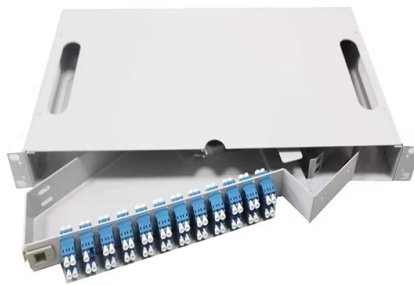

Overview of a Distribution Box A household distribution box, also called a consumer unit or breaker panel, is the central point where incoming electricity from the utility meter is divided into multiple individual circuits, each protected by a Miniature Circuit Breaker (MCB) or Residual Current Breaker with Overcurrent protection (RCBO). The main switch in the panel allows safe isolation of the entire electrical system, but it does not protect individual circuits from overloads or faults. Number of Circuits The exact number of circuits in a home depends on the size of the house, electrical load requirements, and local building codes. Most residential panels are designed with 20 to 40 slots, allowing for individual circuits for lighting, outlets, kitchen appliances, HVAC systems, and dedicated circuits for high-power devices like ovens or electric vehicle chargers. Each slot corresponds to a single circuit, and some appliances may require two-pole breakers, which occupy two slots for 240V circuits.
