

How many fiber optic cables are connected to a switch

- Ring or daisy-chain topology:** Fewer cables may be used, but redundancy and bandwidth can be limited. Modern networks often prefer star topology for reliability.

Redundancy and Future-Proofing Network designers often include extra fiber strands in the cable for future expansion or backup paths. For instance, a 6-core cable may only use 3 cores initially, leaving the remaining cores as spares.
