

# How to apply quota to cable management racks

**Considerations for High-Density or High-Power Equipment** For racks housing PoE++ switches or Wi-Fi 7 access points, cable managers must account for thicker Cat6A cables and higher heat loads, which may require deeper racks and additional vertical space. Proper cable management ensures strain relief, bend-radius compliance, and unobstructed airflow, which are critical for maintaining network performance and equipment longevity.
