

# How to connect 24-core fiber optic cables to a junction box

**Overview** A 24-core fiber optic junction box, also called a splice closure, is used to terminate, splice, distribute, and protect multiple fiber strands in FTTH, FTTx, or outside plant networks. **Cable Entry and Preparation** Identify feeder and distribution cables. Use the designated inlet ports (typically 2 inlets and 2 outlets for horizontal 24-core closures) ( ). Strip the outer jacket carefully without damaging the fibers. Maintain a minimum bend radius of 40 mm to prevent fiber breakage ( ).

**Fiber Splicing** Fibers can be joined using fusion splicing (permanent) or mechanical splicing (semi-permanent) ( ). Organize fibers in splice trays or cassettes to prevent tangling. Optionally, install PLC splitters (1x8 or 1x16) in the tray for signal distribution ( ).

**Fiber Management** Route fibers along predefined paths to avoid crossing or stress. Use fiber holders or clips to secure fibers in place. Ensure SC adapters or connectors are properly seated if using pre-terminated pigtails ( ).

**Sealing and Protection** Close the box using mechanical buckles or screws depending on the model ( ). Ensure IP65 or IP68-rated sealing for waterproofing and dust protection ( ). Verify that the box is impact-resistant and can withstand environmental stress.

**Testing and Verification** After splicing, test each fiber for insertion loss and ret...
