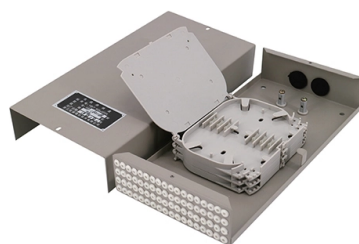


How to connect a four-port fiber optic box to a pigtail

- 6. Connect Pigtail Connectors to Adapters** Insert the factory-terminated connector ends of the pigtails into the corresponding adapters in the four-port box. These adapters allow the pigtails to interface with fiber patch cables or directly with optical transceivers.
- 7. Test the Connections** Use an optical power meter or OTDR to verify signal integrity and ensure low-loss connections. Proper testing ensures the network...
