

How to connect a horizontal cable tray to a vertical cable tray

Attach Fittings: Position the elbow or tee fitting between the vertical and horizontal trays. Use splice kits or hardware provided by the manufacturer to secure the connection.

Secure Supports: Install support brackets or hangers at the top of the bend and along both tray sections. For ladder trays, center-hung supports allow easier cable installation and maintain load capacity.

Check Alignment: Ensure the trays are aligned properly to prevent stress on cables and maintain the correct slope for drainage if outdoors.

Fasten and Inspect: Tighten all bolts and clamps, and inspect the connection for stability and compliance with NEC Article 392 and NEMA VE standards.

Additional Considerations

Maintain minimum bend radius for all cables exiting the vertical tray to avoid insulation damage. For wire mesh trays, cut side and bottom wires at a 45° angle to prevent snagging cables. Ensure load capacity is not exceeded; typical ladder tray hangers support 318–340 kg per hanger with a maximum spacing of 3.6 m. Use corrosion-resistant materials (aluminum, galvanized steel) appropriate for the environment. By following these steps and using the corr...
