

How to connect an 8-core fiber optic cable terminal box

To connect an eight-core fiber optic cable to a terminal box, you must prepare the cable, splice each core to a pigtail, secure the fibers in the splice tray, and connect the pigtails to the adapter ports.

Step 1: Prepare the Terminal Box Choose a terminal box that supports 8-core fiber splicing and is suitable for your installation environment (indoor or outdoor) with proper IP rating for dust and water protection . Mount the box securely on a wall, pole, or rack, ensuring the cable entry point is accessible and allows smooth routing without sharp bends .

Step 2: Prepare the Fiber Cable Strip the outer jacket of the fiber optic cable carefully to expose the eight individual cores. Remove the protective coating from each fiber core using a fiber stripper, taking care not to damage the glass fiber . Clean each fiber with alcohol wipes to remove debris.

Step 3: Splice Fibers to Pigtails Insert the prepared fibers into the splice tray inside the terminal box. Use fusion splicing to connect each fiber core to a corresponding pigtail. The pigtails are pre-connectorized fibers that will later plug into the adapter ports . Ensure each splice is neat and properly aligned to minimize signal loss.

Step 4: Secure and Route Fibers Place the spliced fibers into the splice tray and secure them using the tray's fiber holders. Store any excess fiber in controlled loops to prevent bending beyond the minimum radius, which can degrade signal quality . Route the pigtails to the adapter panel carefully.

Step 5: Connect Pigtails to Adapters Insert the pigtail connectors into the fiber adapters (flanges) on the terminal box. These adapters serve as the interface for connecting jumpers or patch cords to devices . Ensure each connector clicks securely into place and is labeled for easy identification.

Step 6: Test the Connection After all fibers are connected, test the network using an Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) or visual fault locator...
