

How to connect fiber optic equipment to a router

Tips for Optimal Performance

- Place the ONT close to the fiber entry point to minimize signal loss.
- Keep both ONT and router in a dry, ventilated area near power outlets, ideally with surge protection.
- Use wired connections for high-bandwidth applications like gaming or video conferencing.
- Regularly monitor internet speed and adjust router settings if performance drops.

Troubleshooting

If the connection fails, check that the fiber cable is properly seated in the ONT and that protective caps were removed. Verify that th...
