- Position the Distribution Box:** Place the box on a stable, dry surface, ensuring it is accessible for equipment connections and protected from water or debris.
- Connect the Power Source:** Use the appropriate industrial plug to connect the generator or grid supply to the input of the distribution box. Ensure the source is switched off during connection to prevent arcing or shock.
- Verify Circuit Protection:** Check that all breakers and GFCIs are in the correct position and functional. Test the system if possible before c...
