

How to connect the fiber optic cable from the fiber distribution box

Fusion Splicing: Align the fiber with a pigtail or another fiber and use a fusion splicer to permanently join them.
Connector Termination: If using pre-terminated connectors, insert each fiber into the corresponding adapter port on the distribution box, ensuring proper alignment and secure locking.

Step 5: Route and Manage Fibers Organize the fibers inside the box using bend radius control clips and cable ties. Avoid exceeding the minimum bend radius to prevent signal degradation. Secure the main trunk and route branch fibers to their respective ports, keeping the layout neat and accessible for maintenance.
