

How to connect the fiber optic interface panel socket

3. **Prepare the Wall Socket** Choose a dry, accessible wall near power outlets. Cut a hole in the drywall according to the socket template (typically 60mm x 40mm). Secure the back box with screws, ensuring a minimum depth of 40mm .
4. **Prepare the Fiber Cable** Strip approximately 30cm of the incoming fiber cable. Clean the fiber end with alcohol wipes to remove dust and contaminants. Avoid bending the fiber sharply; maintain a minimum bend radius of 30mm .
5. **Install the Pigtail and Adapter** Snap the pre-terminated fiber pigtail into the socket adapter inside the back box. Coil any excess fiber neatly to prevent stress or damage. Attach the faceplate to the back box for a flush, tidy finish .
6. **Connect to the ONT or Router** Use a fiber patch cable (matching connector type, e.g., SC/APC to SC/APC) to link the wall socket to the ONT. Ensure the ONT is powered and positioned close to the socket to minimize signal loss .
7. **Test the Connection** Measure light levels if possible; for GPON networks, a good range is typically -8 dBm to -27 dBm. Verify that your router or ONT is receiving a stable signal and that internet connectivity is functional .
