Optical switches manipulate the refractive index of materials or use movable mirrors to direct light along different paths. This allows high-speed routing while avoiding the energy cost and latency of repeated electrical conversions. Advanced technologies like optical transistors can even amplify or switch optical signals entirely in the optical domain, enabling ultrafast all-optical networks.
