- Multimode (MM: OM1/OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5): Best for short-distance connections within the same building or data center. Core sizes range from $50\mu\text{m}$ to $62.5\mu\text{m}$, with color-coded jackets for easy identification ().

Connector Types

Common connectors include:

- LC: Small, duplex, widely used in modern networks and compatible with QSFP transceivers.
- SC: Larger, simplex or duplex, often used in older installations.
- ST: Bayonet-style, less common today.
- MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors for high-density applications, supporting 40G, 100G, and beyond ().

- PVC: Standard indoor use.
- Plenum (OFNP): Fire-resistant, suitable for air ducts.
- Riser (OFNR): For vertical shafts between floors.
- LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen): Emits minimal smoke and toxic gases, common in Europe and high-safety areas ().
