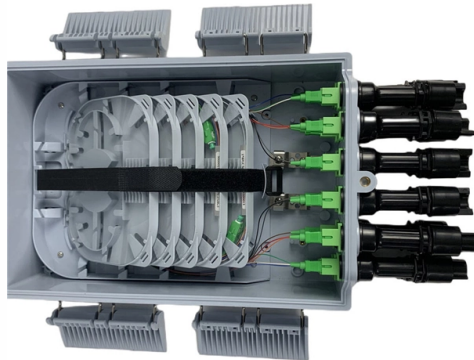


How to install large cables into cable trays

Mounting and Support Install supports at regular intervals according to the tray manufacturer's specifications, typically every 1.5 to 3 meters depending on load. Use wall arms, ceiling struts, or floor supports to secure the tray. Ensure trays are level and aligned, and use couplers or splice plates to connect sections. For bends or risers, use pre-fabricated fittings to maintain structural integrity.
