

How to lay cables in a ladder-type cable tray

- Install Expansion Fittings if Needed:** For long runs, include expansion joints to accommodate thermal expansion and prevent stress on cables.

Bonding and Grounding: Ensure the tray and cables are properly bonded to maintain electrical safety.
