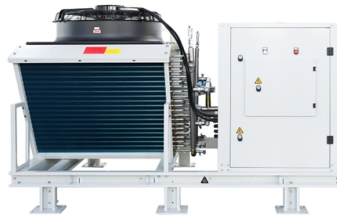


How to make cable trays in a vertical cable shaft

Install Supports: Use threaded rods, Unistrut channels, or center-hung hangers to secure the tray to the building structure. Ensure supports are plumb and capable of bearing the maximum anticipated load, including cables. Seismic restraints should be installed where required.

Assemble and Secure Trays: Connect tray sections using standard fittings and splice plates. Ensure rungs are level and aligned, and remove any burrs or sharp edges to prevent cable damage. Use spring knots or retaining bars to prevent trays from shifting during installation.
