

How to reconnect my Huijue fiber optic switch when the network is down

Check IP and Routing Settings: Ensure there are no IP conflicts or misconfigured routes.

Update Firmware: Make sure the Huijue switch and any connected devices are running the latest firmware to prevent compatibility issues.
