

How to use a 100Mbps fiber optic switch

Step 3: Access the Switch Connect your computer to the switch using an Ethernet cable or console connection. Use a terminal client like PuTTY to log in to the switch with the switch's IP address. Configure basic settings such as hostname, enable password, and management IP if not already set.

Step 4: Configure Port Speed and Duplex For 100FX SFP ports, manually set the speed to 100 Mbps and the duplex mode to full (or half if required). On ExtremeSwitching devices, the command format is:

```
CodeCopyconfigure ports port_list {medium fiber} auto off speed 100 duplex full
```

If autonegotiation is enabled, the switch will automatically select the best speed and duplex supported by the connected device.

Step 5: Configure VLANs Create or assign a VLAN for the fiber ports to separate network traffic. For example, on Cisco switches:

```
CodeCopyvlan 10name Fiber_VLANinterface range gi1/0/1 - 2switchport mode accessswitchport access vlan 10
```

This ensures that fiber traffic is properly segmented and managed.

Step 6: Verify Connectivity Check the link status and port LEDs to confirm the fiber connection is active. Use commands like `show interfaces status` or `show vlan brief` to verify that the port is up and assigned to the correct VLAN.

Step 7: Save Configuration After completing the setup, save the configuration...
