

How to wire the distribution box for an electricity meter

Connect the hot wires (usually black and red) to the line terminals of the main double-pole (DP) breaker. Connect the neutral wire (white or gray) to the isolated neutral bus bar. Connect the grounding conductor (green or bare copper) to the ground bus bar, which should be bonded to the metallic enclosure and external grounding electrodes.

Step 4: Installing Protective Devices Install the main DP breaker as the primary isolator. Add RCDs (Residual Current Devices) for safety, especially in wet areas. Connect single-pole (SP) breakers for lighting, outlets, and appliances according to their load ratings (e.g., 10A, 16A, 20A). Ensure each circuit is properly labeled for easy identification.

Step 5: Wiring Branch Circuits Connect the outgoing hot wires from SP breakers to the respective sub-circuits. Connect the neutral wires from each sub-circuit to the neutral bus. Connect all earth wires to the ground bus to maintain proper earthing. For 240V appliances, use a double-pole breaker connecte...
