A distribution box is a low-voltage electrical enclosure that receives incoming power and distributes it safely to multiple outgoing circuits through protective and switching devices such as MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, isolators, busbars, neutral bars, earth bars, and surge protective devices. The “first outlet” is the initial point of distribution on that circuit, receiving power directly from the main panel wiring before it is distributed further. A surge protective device (SPD) sits on the supply side where a risk assessment requires it.
