Proper labeling, arc flash hazard analysis, and safe maintenance access are required to prevent accidents . **Wiring and Electrical Connections** Power must be turned off during installation to ensure safety . Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the expected load . Maintain neat cable management, clear wire identification, and secure cable entry points . Include short-circuit protection devices such as circuit breakers or fuses for each circuit . Ensure grounding and earthing of the metal enclosure, electrical boards, and internal appliances to protect against electrical faults . **Protection and Safety Devices** Each circuit should have its own breaker, fuse, or surge protector to prevent overloads and short circuits . Regular inspection and maintenance are recommended to detect iss...
