NEC also requires a clear working space in front of the panel, typically 30 inches wide, 36 inches deep, and 6.5 feet high, to maintain safe access.

- Moisture Protection:** Avoid installing near sinks, uncovered outdoor areas, or locations prone to flooding.
- Safety:** Place the box away from potential impacts or hazards, and ensure it is firmly mounted on a stable surface.
- Maintenance Convenience:** The height should facilitate inspection, replacement, and repairs without requiring ladders or tools.

Summary For most residential and light commercial installations, mount the distribution box at 1.4–1.7 meters for indoor use, at least 3 feet above ground for outdoor use, and ensure the top breaker does not exceed 2 meters from the floor to comply with NEC...
