- Wiring and Conduit Requirements** Conductors must be routed through conduits (PVC, RSC, or EMT) to protect against physical damage. Branch circuit conductors extend from the distribution box to lighting fixtures, outlets, and appliances. Proper termination with secure mechanical connections and wire connectors is essential.
- Grounding and Bonding** A dedicated grounding conductor must run alongside current-carrying wires, terminating at the grounding busbar in the panelboard. The busbar is bonded to the neutral bar and connected to a grounding electrode system, such as a ground rod, to dissipate surge energy and prevent electrical hazards.
- Overcurrent Protection** Each branch circuit must be protected...
