

Instructions for Low-Loss Installation of Optical Cable Relay Stand

- Hand-tighten connectors only: Do not use tools to tighten, as over-tightening can damage the fiber and increase insertion loss.

Installation on Relay Stands

- Follow manufacturer guidelines: For relay systems like REA Arc Protection or Hirschmann OBR40, ensure the fiber is routed according to the relay's sensor or lens fiber layout to detect light accurately.
- Grounding and power considerations: Ensure the relay stand is properly grounded and that power supply lines meet the specified voltage and fuse requirements.
- Avoid mechanical stress: Do not place heavy objects on the fiber or allow it to rub against sharp edges.
