Proper Sizing of Distribution Boxes Household distribution boxes must be sized to accommodate the number of circuit switches, incoming wire size, and terminal connections. For boxes handling lighting circuits or small power loads with fewer than 20 switches and wire sizes under 10 mm², the width should equal the sum of switch widths plus 20 mm on each side, the height should be switch height plus 40 mm, and the depth should be the maximum switch depth plus 10 mm. For more than 20 switches, two rows should be used, with width calculated as the sum of switch widths plus 40 mm, height as switch height plus 40 mm, and depth as maximum switch depth plus 10 mm. Power distribution boxes with larger wires require additional space for bending radius and terminal connections (). Required Working Space Around Panels The National Electrical Code (NEC) mandates clear working space around electrical panels to ensure safe operation and maintenance. Minimum requirements include: Front clearance: At least 36 inches (3 feet) from the panel face to allow safe access and door operation (). Width: Minimum 30 inches or the full width of the panel, whichever is greater (). Height: Clear space from the floor to 6 feet 6 inches or the height of the equipment, whichever is taller (). Side clearance: At least 30 inches from the sides of the panel, or the width of the equipment if greater (). These clearances prevent obstruction, allow proper airflow to avoid overheating, and provide safe access for inspection, maintenance, or emergency response ().
