Overview

Internal switchboard busbars—sometimes called the main busbar or main bus bar of an assembly—are part of a switchgear busbar system verified to IEC 61439-1/-2 (global) or UL 891 (North America). Busbars are the backbone of a low-voltage switchboard: rigid conductors that collect and distribute current safely between incoming devices and outgoing feeders. In most assemblies you will find horizontal main bars, vertical risers, neutral and equipment-ground buses, and purpose-designed. Core idea: A busbar is a conductive bar or assembly that creates a common current distribution point inside electrical equipment.
