- Wire Mesh Tray (Cable Basket):** Lightweight, flexible, and easy to modify. Excellent for frequent changes or additions in commercial offices and LAN networks.

Design Considerations

- Cable Type and Diameter:** Identify all cable types and their outer diameters to ensure proper tray sizing.
- Total Quantity and Weight:** Calculate the total weight per meter/foot, including a 20-30% growth margin for future expansion.
- Bend Radius:** Maintain minimum bend radius, especially for fiber optics, to prevent signal loss.
- Fill Ratio:** Industry standard is 40-50% maximum fill to allow heat dissipation, prevent crushing, and facilitate maintenance.
- Material and Environment:** Choose materials based on installation conditions: Indoor vs. Outdoor: Outdoor trays require corrosion-resistant coatings like hot-dip galvanizing or aluminum. Corrosive Environments: Stainless steel or heavy-duty aluminum is recommended for industri...
