

# Methods to increase delay in the light control module

  - Increasing the resistance in series with the capacitor, often via a variable resistor or potentiometer, which also extends the timing interval. This method is common in standalone or homemade light delay circuits and allows fine-tuning of the delay from seconds to several minutes.
- 3. Using Programmable Time Delay Relays** For more precise or longer delays, programmable time delay relays can be integrated into the lighting system. These relays allow users to set on-delay or off-delay times ranging from milliseconds to hours, depending on the model. Some advanced relays also support digital programming, remote control via Bluetooth or Zigbee, and integration with smart building systems, providing flexibility for both indoor and outdoor lighting applications.
