

Multiple electrical devices in a three-level distribution box

In a three-level distribution system, each electrical device should ideally have its own dedicated tertiary distribution box with individual circuit protection to ensure safety and compliance.

Overview of Three-Level Distribution

A three-level distribution system consists of:

- Primary Distribution Box (Main Distribution Board):** Connected directly to the transformer (0.4kV), it serves as the central hub for power distribution. It does not supply power directly to devices but includes isolating switches, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs) for overall system safety.
- Secondary Distribution Box (Sub-Distribution Board):** Supplies power to specific buildings, floors, or zones. It handles three-phase power for heavy loads like motors and machinery. Secondary boxes often include larger three-phase breakers and RCDs for intermediate protection.
- Tertiary Distribution Box (Switch Box):** The final connection point for individual devices or household equipment, delivering 220V single-phase power. Each device is typically connected to its own circuit breaker and RCD, following the principle of "one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box".

Connecting Multiple Devices

Safety Principle: A single tertiary distribution box should not control multiple devices through one switch or breaker. Each device requires independent protection to prevent overloads, short circuits, or leakage hazards.

Two-Layer Protection: RCDs are installed at both the tertiary (device-level) and secondary (zone-level) stages. This ensures that any fault in a device triggers disconnection without affecting other circuits.

Portable vs Fixed Boxes: Tertiary boxes can be fixed or portable, but each must maintain individual circuit protection. This is especially important on construction sites or large projects where multiple devices operate simultaneously.
