 - Maintaining minimum bend radius to prevent signal loss
 - Avoiding excessive pulling or twisting
 - Keeping connectors clean and defect-free
 - Splicing cables carefully for lengths exceeding factory spool limitsTechnicians install Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at subscriber locations for FTTH connections, converting optical signals into digital data for end-user devices.
