Network cables entering a house should be routed carefully to a central distribution box, considering cable type, bend radius, and accessibility for future connections. Planning the Route Before installation, plan the cable path from the entry point to the distribution box. Identify obstacles such as door frames, skirting boards, or walls, and measure the total cable length required, allowing extra for bends and routing around corners. For fiber optic cables, maintain a minimum bend radius (typically around 30mm) to prevent signal loss or damage. Ethernet cables (Cat5e/Cat6) are more flexible but should still avoid sharp bends and kinks. Choosing the Cable Type Fiber optic cable: Used for high-speed internet connections, typically terminating at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT) near the distribution box. Ethernet cable (Cat5e/Cat6): Connects the ONT to the router and other devices. Can run up to 100 meters without signal degradation. Coaxial or phone cables: Optional for TV or landline connections, routed through the same distribution panel if needed. Installing the Distribution Box The distribution box (also called a structured wiring panel) is the central hub where all incoming cables meet and are distributed to different rooms. Place it in a central, accessible location, such as a basement, closet, or utility room, to simplify future cable runs. Cut wall openings if necessary and secure the box to a stud or wall surface. Routing and Securing Cables Run cables along walls, skirting boards, or through conduits to protect them. Avoid 90-degree bends for fiber; use gentle curves around corners. Label each cable at both ends for easy identification. Ensure the ONT has access to a power source, either directly from a wall socket or via a trailing lead, as installers typically allow either option. Connecting Devices Connect the incoming fiber to the ONT, then run a Cat6 cable from the ONT...
