- Third Quartile (Q3):** 75% of data fall below this value.
- Maximum:** The highest value, excluding outliers.

The interquartile range (IQR), represented by the box, shows the middle 50% of the data, while the whiskers extend to the remaining data range. Outliers are often marked with dots or asterisks beyond the whiskers. These numbers allow you to quickly assess the central tendency, spread, skewness, and potential outliers in your dataset.
