Unlock Interlocks: Only after grounding is confirmed can the cubicle door be unlocked.

Open Door Carefully: Open the door slowly, observing for any signs of voltage or abnormal conditions ().

Closing Procedure

Check Internal Components: Ensure all internal connections, breakers, and switches are correctly positioned.

Close Door and Engage Interlocks: The door must be fully closed to engage safety interlocks.

Operate Circuit Breaker: Using the spring-driven or motorized mechanism, close the breaker to reconnect the circuit. The mechanism ensures fast and reliable closure to maintain system stability ().

Verify System Operation: Confirm that the system is energized correctly and that all protection relays and monitoring devices are functioning.
