

Optical module connecting switch to router



AI Overview

Routers and switches can be interconnected using compatible optical modules (SFP, SFP+, QSFP) and fiber patch cords, ensuring high-speed, low-loss, and scalable network connections.

Optical Module Selection To connect a router to a switch via fiber, you need to select an optical transceiver that matches the data rate, fiber type, and distance between devices:

- Data Rate:** Common modules include 1.25G SFP, 10G SFP+, 25G SFP28, 40G QSFP+, and 100G QSFP28.
- Fiber Type:** Single-mode fiber (SMF) is used for long distances, while multimode fiber (MMF) is suitable for shorter distances.
- Distance:** Choose modules based on the span between devices. For example, a 300m link can use a 10G multimode optical module with a multimode patch cord.

Connection Setup

- Insert Optical Modules:** Plug the SFP/SFP+ module into the router and switch ports. These modules are often hot-swappable, allowing installation without powering down the devices.
- Use Fiber Patch Cables:** Connect the router and switch using fiber patch cords compatible with the module type (single-mode or multimode).
- Configure Interfaces:** On the router, configure the SFP/SFP+ interface as a WAN or LAN port depending on the network topology.
- Verify Compatibility:** Some ISPs or enterprise networks require verified modules, especially when using PON (Passive Optical Network) solutions, to ensure proper operation and compliance with standards.

Practical Considerations

- PON Integration:** In routed PON deployments, the router can host a pluggable OLT module, replacing a traditional OLT chassis and connecting directly to ONTs, reducing power and space requirements.
- Enterprise Networks:** Correct module matching ensures low loss, high stability, and long service life, which is critical for data centers and broadband access networks.
- Future Scalability:** Some solutions allow upgrading from 10G to 25G optics without...
