This is often done using busbars or single-bolt parallel groove connectors with heat shrink sleeves to safely join multiple wires. Avoiding Jumpers: Older methods used jumpers—wires connecting the top of one MCB to the next—but this is unsafe because the first wire carries the sum of currents from all downstream circuits, risking overheating and fire hazards. Modern standards prohibit this method. Neutral and Earth Connections: Neutral wires from all branch circuits are connected to a neutral busbar, and earth wires are connected to the earth busbar, ensuring proper grounding and safety. Key Safety Considerations Use proper connectors: Single-bolt parallel groove connectors or busbars are recommended to handle multiple wires safely. Maintain spacing: Ensure enough space between the main switch and branch MCBs for wire routing, and cover exposed areas with circuit breaker baffles if needed. Correct wire sizing: Each wire should be rated for the expected current of its branch circuit to prevent overheating. By following these pr...
