Tertiary Distribution Box: The final distribution point, delivering single-phase 220V power to household or equipment-level circuits. It emphasizes local control and safety, often following the "one device, one circuit breaker, one RCD, one box" principle .

Components and Safety Mechanisms

Bus Bars: Conductive strips (copper or aluminum) that distribute power from the main breaker to individual circuits .

Circuit Breakers/Fuses: Protect circuits from overloads and short circuits by interrupting power when current exceeds safe limits .

Neutral and Earth Bars: Ensure safe return paths for current and prevent electrical hazards .

Main Breaker: Controls the total power entering the distribution box and allows complete shutdown if necessary .
