

Pre-opening testing of optical cable reel

A pre-opening inspection of an optical cable reel ensures the cable and reel are undamaged, properly stored, and meet technical specifications before installation.

Visual and Physical Inspection Before opening the reel, inspect the reel and cable for any visible damage, such as cracks, dents, or signs of moisture, and confirm that the reel is stored on solid, level ground to prevent flange sinking or deformation (Corning) . Ensure the reel is oriented according to the directional arrow on the flange and avoid sliding it with forklifts. Fiber and Connector Inspection Inspect the fiber endfaces and connectors using a video microscope or fiberscope. Check for dirt, scratches, or contamination. If the inspection fails, clean the connectors using appropriate tools such as isopropanol wipes or click cleaners, ensuring the correct ferrule size is used . Always keep protective caps on unused connectors to prevent contamination .

Optical Testing Perform basic optical tests to confirm fiber integrity. Measure fiber length, attenuation, and continuity using an OTDR or, if unavailable, a light source and optical power meter. Compare results with manufacturer data to ensure consistency . For long cables with splices, verify each splice with an OTDR to ensure proper performance .

Handling and Safety Precautions Maintain cleanliness during handling to prevent contamination. Limit maximum tension according to cable specifications (e.g., 600 lbs for outside plant cables) and observe minimum bend radius requirements . Always disconnect the ca...
