- Three-Phase Systems:** Capacitors are often connected in a delta or wye configuration depending on system requirements. Delta connections are common for balanced three-phase loads, while wye connections may be used for neutral grounding or specific voltage levels.

Special Considerations for Main-Tie-Main Systems

In Main-Tie-Main setups, capacitor banks require careful placement of current transformers (CTs):

- One CT is installed after the main incoming breaker, facing the main breaker.
- A second CT is installed before the tie breaker, facing the tie breaker....
