Environmental Protection: First-level boxes are often installed outdoors and must be rainproof and dustproof. Use enclosures with IP65 or higher ratings to prevent water ingress and dust accumulation. High-grade polyurethane gaskets and heavy-duty latches help maintain a continuous seal against moisture and mechanical impacts.

Electrical Safety: Implement two-level protection by installing leakage protectors both in the first-level box and in downstream switch boxes. Follow the principle of “one machine, one switch, one leakage, one box, one lock” to prevent a single switch from controlling multiple devices, reducing the risk of overload or short circuits.

Material and Construction: Use steel or reinforced plastic enclosures for durability. Internal mounting plates should be made of galvanized steel or reinforced fiberglass, with adjustable grids to secure heavy circuit breakers and DIN rails. Molded mounting pillars help isolate components from condensation.

Installation Guidelines

Placement: Install the box in a dry, accessible area with good ventilation, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters.
