

Regulations on Power Outage Time for Construction Site Distribution Boxes

- IP-Rated Enclosures:** Distribution boards must be robust and weatherproof (minimum IP44) to protect against dust, water, and mechanical damage.
- Circuit Breakers and Disconnects:** Each circuit should have breakers or disconnecting means visible from the controller location, allowing safe isolation during outages or maintenance.
- Regular Inspections:** Electrical installations should undergo quarterly EICR inspections to ensure compliance and detect potential risks before outages occur.

Operational Considerations While there is no legally mandated maximum outage time, best practices include:

- Minimizing downtime:** Power should be restored as quickly as possible to maintain safe lighting, hoist operation, and equipment functionality.
- Backup power:** For critical operations, generators or alternative power sources should be available to reduce the impact of outages.
