

Replacing the optical module power switch



AI Overview

You can replace a power supply or optical module in most modern switches while the device remains powered on, provided you follow proper hot-swappable procedures and safety precautions.

Safety Precautions Before replacing a power switch or optical module, ensure you:

- Wear an ESD wrist strap or gloves to prevent electrostatic discharge damage to sensitive components.
- Do not touch electrical connectors or the edge of optical modules during installation.
- Use dust plugs on unconnected optical ports to prevent contamination.
- Verify module compatibility, ensuring the new module matches the power type, airflow direction, and optical parameters of the existing system.

Replacing a Power Supply Module

- Check redundancy:** Ensure the other power supply is operational to maintain switch functionality.
- Disconnect power cables:** Shut off the power source if required, then disconnect the power cable by pressing the release tab.
- Remove the module:** Press the release latch, support the module with your other hand, and slide it out carefully without touching connectors.
- Install the new module:** Slide the replacement into the slot until it clicks, ensuring airflow direction matches other modules.
- Reconnect power cables:** Attach the power cables securely and verify that LEDs indicate proper operation.

Replacing an Optical Module

- Disconnect optical fibers:** Release the locking clips and gently remove fibers, covering connectors with dust caps.
- Remove the old module:** Pull the module straight out without forcing it. If it resists, check orientation and try again.
- Install the new module:** Align correctly and push gently until it clicks into place.
- Reconnect fibers:** Remove dust caps and insert fibers carefully, ensuring correct labeling and orientation.
- Test the connection:** If the module does not work, clean fiber connectors with an alcohol swab and reconnect.

Take out the new optical module from the package. Ensure that the optical module is correctly oriented and gently push it into the optical port until you hear a click.
