Bend radius: Maintain the manufacturer-specified minimum bend radius to prevent stress or damage to cables. Segregation: Separate power, control, and communication lines to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI). Protection: Use conduits, armored cables, or cable trays to shield cables from mechanical damage.

Mounting and Placement Install boxes in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation and at a recommended height of approximately 1.5 meters. Ensure the box is securely mounted to withstand physical impacts from equipment, branches, or other external forces. Avoid direct exposure to heat sources or sunlight that could affect internal temperatures and device performance.

Electrical and Safety Compliance All connections must be housed in approved weatherproof enclosures as required by NEC Article 314. Use wet-rated conductors (e.g., THWN-2) for outdoor wiring, and protect UF cables with conduit if exposed. Include grounding, circuit bre...
