Internal Components and Wiring Inside the box, components include circuit breakers, busbars, terminal blocks, and DIN rails for mounting additional devices. Wiring should use high-temperature resistant copper conductors with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load. Proper cable management, insulation, and labeling are essential. Each circuit should have its own protective device, such as a breaker, fuse, or surge protector.

Dimensions and Capacity For boxes handling lighting or small power loads, the width, height, and depth should accommodate the number of switches plus additional clearance (typically 20–40 mm). For larger power distribution boxes, consider the bending radius of incoming wires and allow space for terminal connecti...
