- Monitor pulling tension and avoid exceeding the cable's maximum load rating, typically at least 2700 N for outdoor cables.
- Roll cable off the spool rather than spinning it to prevent stress on fibers.
- Use innerducts for indoor or exposed installations to protect against accidental cuts or damage.
