

Resetting Mobile Fiber Optic Router Settings

- Log in:** Use your administrator username and password. If remote access is needed, ensure it is enabled via Dynamic DNS or VPN.
- Select restart/reset option:** Navigate to the management panel and choose the option to reboot or reset the router.
