- Reset the Router:** If the red light persists, perform a factory reset following the manufacturer's instructions. Note that this will erase custom settings.
- Contact ISP Support:** If none of the above steps resolve the issue, your ISP can check the connection remotely or replace faulty equipment.

- Avoid bending the fiber optic cable sharply, as it can break the internal fibers.
- Ensure the router is placed in a well-ventilated area to prevent overheating.
