Disconnect and Remove Cables: Carefully disconnect cables from devices and patch panels. Use fish tapes and pull rods for cables running through walls or ceilings.

Sort and Collect Materials: Separate metal parts by type for recycling or disposal. Organize removed cables and clean the area to maintain a safe and clutter-free environment.
