Installation Considerations Proper installation is critical for effective surge protection: Short and direct earth connections: Earth wires should be as short as possible to minimize impedance and maximize surge diversion. Physical separation of wiring: Reduces electrostatic and electromagnetic coupling between circuits, preventing surges from transferring between signal lines. DIN rail mounting: Many modern surge modules, such as the M-LB-4000 or M-LB-2000, are compact and mountable on standard DIN rails, allowing tool-free installation and easy replacement without interrupting signal circuits.
