Additional Considerations Fiber Capacity: Wall-mounted boxes often use 12-fiber splice trays, while rack-mounted ODFs can integrate splitters (1:4 or 1:8) and support hundreds of fibers. Installation Flexibility: Rack-mounted ODFs can be installed back-to-back or side-by-side, sometimes with angle brackets for wall attachment. Material and Build: Most boxes are made of cold-rolled steel or durable plastic, with features to maintain fiber bend radius and protect against environmental factors. In summary, the dimensions of an optical distribution box depend on its mounting type and fiber capacity, with wall-mounted units being compact for indoor telecom rooms and rack-mounted ODFs conforming to standard 19" rack widths with variable heights for larger network deployments.
